Yarn
Medium 4


Hook
5mm / US 8-H

Gauge
Daisy Square
= 3.25" x 3.25"

Finished Size
00" x 00" (with handles)

Yardage
350 yds
MC = 150 yds
CC 1 = 50 yds
CC 2 = 50 yds
CC 3 = 50 yds
CC 4 = 50 yds

MC = Main Color
CC = Contrasting Color



FRONT + BACK
PANELS (2x)



SIDE PANELS
(4x)



HANDLES
(2x)

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Make 18 daisy squares, switching up the colors to your preference. (See next page for daisy square instructions)

FRONT PANEL

Seam 9 Squares together
DC 3 rows on top and bottom

BACK PANEL

Repeat front panel

SIDE PANEL


Chain 13. DC into 3rd chain from hook. DC into remaining chains. 12 DC total.
Chain 3, DC to end of row.
Repeat 26 times (28 rows, total)
Make 4 side panels.

HANDLE


Chain 13. DC into 3rd chain from hook. DC into remaining chains. 12 DC total.
Chain 3, DC to end of row.
Repeat 00 times (00 rows, total)
Repeat to make second handle (2 handles, total).

CONSTRUCTION

Whip Stitch two side panels together, along one long edge. Repeat for opposite side. (Two sides made)




Whip handles to the front panel, aligning on the outside edges. Flip over and whip stitch other ends of handles to the back panel.



Place the side panels between the front and back panels, outside edges aligning. Pin or clip bag in place, being careful not to twist straps.

Overhead view



Seam along one side, using a slip stitch to join pieces together. Continue up, around the handle and down the back side. Continue on to join the bottom, then travel up and around the opposite side. Fasten off.

Reattach yarn to the inner side of one of the handles. Use a slip stitch to finish the edges of the handles and top of the bag. Fasten off.

Weave in all loose ends.

Row 2

Attach yarn into any chain space on ring. Chain 1 and pull up loop to 1/2". Yarn over.

Insert hook into same chain space where yarn was attached, yarn over and pull up a loop to 1/2". Yarn over. Insert hook into chain space, yarn over and pull up a loop to 1/2". Yarn over. Insert hook into chain space, yarn over and pull up a loop to 1/2". Yarn over and pull through all 7 loops on hook. **Petal stitch** made. Chain 1.

Repeat this stitch all the way around, 12 **petal stitches** total.

When you arrive back at the beginning of the round, insert your hook into the top of the first petal stitch, yarn over and pull through both loops on hook. Fasten off.



Row 3

Attach yarn to any chain 1 space in previous row. Chain 3. (Acts as first treble crochet)

Treble crochet two more times in same chain 1 space. (This is half of a corner. You will make the other half at the end, after you work your way around the outside.) Chain 1.

Make three **double crochet** stitches in next chain 1 space. Chain 1.

Three **double crochet** stitches in next chain 1 space. Chain 1.

Make three **treble crochet** stitches in next chain 1 space, chain 2 and make three more treble crochet stitches in same space. Corner made. Chain 1.

Repeat steps in brackets two times.

Three **double crochet** stitches in the next chain 1 space. Chain 1.

Three **double crochet** stitches in next chain 1 space. Chain 1.

Back to first half-corner made. Make three **treble crochet** stitches in same chain 1 space. Chain 2 and connect to first 3 treble crochet stitches made. Fasten off.

Weave in ends with a tapestry needle.

Row 1

Create a magic circle: chain 3 (acts as first double crochet), **double crochet** into ring 11 times equals 12 double crochet total. Tighten and bind off.
